- 1. Review program guidelines, download the pdf Application Form
 - a. If applicant is landowner/farmer
 - i. Fill out your contact information form; be sure to include the PID of the proposed project field.
 - ii. Applicants are encouraged to contact their local Watershed Coordinator to discuss their project.
 - iii. If you don't know who your local coordinator is, click the link for Watershed Groups to find contact information for the group in your area, email info@peiawp.com or call 902-394-7933 for assistance.
 - iv. If you are not the owner of the land of the proposed project, the landowner must sign and date the application in the space at the bottom of the form marked: "if neither applicant is the landowner, please have the landowner sign here:"
 - b. If applicant is a watershed coordinator wishing to nominate a project
 - i. Fill out your contact information form; be sure to include the PID of the proposed project field.
 - ii. Contact the landowner/farmer to discuss the project; check the yes box to the question: Have you been in contact with the property owner/farmer regarding this application? Fill in the landowner/farmer's name and contact information in the space provided. The landowner must sign and date the application in the space provided for the application to proceed.
- 2. Applications will be accepted throughout 2023 or until funds allocated to this program are committed.
